I agree with the Paynesville City Council, the Task Force and the Roseville Township Board (of which I am a member), in their disapproval of the Far West route. We believe this route would be the death of our town. This was the reason we wanted this route dropped at an earlier time; to stop further money from being spent on it.

Of the remaining options, the no build does not seem very realistic. The other routes would all work for Paynesville in that the traffic would be close to the town. I further agree with the city council, task force, and Roseville township boarding favoring the West route.
